

Nebraska Walk For Life

Saturday, January 28, 2012

10 a.m. West Side, State Capitol, 14th & K Streets, Lincoln

11:30 a.m. UN-L Student Union, 14th & R Streets

The Nebraska Walk for Life is an event sponsored by Nebraska Right to Life since 1974. It has become the largest First Amendment demonstration in the State, bringing 3,000 to 5,000 pro-lifers from across Nebraska to march in solidarity against Roe v. Wade and in support of women and teens facing unplanned pregnancies.

A short program at the Capitol will be followed by marching at approximately 10:30 a.m. down 14th Street to the University of Nebraska Student Union at 14th & R Streets. Inside the Union's second floor Ballroom and Centennial Room will be hot beverages, food and information tables.

Our keynote speaker, Ryan Bomberger, will speak at approximately 11:45 a.m. The event will conclude by 1 p.m. Dress warmly, bring signs and remember, the Walk is a free, family-friendly, peaceful, legal event.

Parking is allowed around the Capitol, south of the Capitol and at downtown pay parking garages or metered parking between the Student Union and Capitol.

(3), with his wife, Bethany. They have made an unexpected impact in the pro-life movement with the bold TooManyAborted.com billboard/web campaigns. As the first pro-adoption themed ad campaign created to address the disproportionate impact of abortion in the black community, the effort received massive media coverage, enabling The Radiance Foundation, and Ryan's personal story of adoption, to reach millions. Working with noted national civil rights leaders like Dr. Alveda King (niece of Dr. Martin Luther King Jr.), Ryan is involved in national efforts to expose and defund Planned Parenthood by illuminating this human rights injustice. He is a featured blogger at LifeNews.com and addresses the cultural dynamics of abortion, eugenics, and the beautiful act of adoption.
